CAP after 2013

Scenarios for the coming CAP

- I. No changes before 2020
- II. Phasing out direct payment from 2013 till 2020
- III. Support aimed at activities with elements of public goods



CAP after 2013

Dismantling of subsidies

- I. Agricultural subsidies are capitalized and included in farm prices**
- II. The phasing out must be gradual, open and transparent**
- III. The phasing out must be made over two budget periods from 2014 to 2027**



CAP after 2013

Innovation, Research and Development

- I. Agriculture must add new values for the benefit of the farmers and the environment**
- II. Agriculture must be in the frontline**
- III. Agriculture must use new knowledge**
- IV. Agriculture must develop new techniques and new products**



CAP after 2013

Different point of views concerning the future CAP

- I. **Continued support of the agricultural sector**
Retention of support schemes, intervention and direct payment
- II. **Liberalisation and market orientation**
Phase out of coupled schemes, other support schemes, intervention, export restitutions and direct payments

Important points for further discussion

- I. **Environment, animal welfare, food security**
- II. **Further support especially in less favoured areas**
- III. **Compensation to the farmers for protection of nature, environment, biodiversity**
- IV. **Compensation to the farmers for reduction of emission of CO₂, measures against flooding and drought**
